

## **Riverton Memorial Hospital moves to tobacco-free campus**

Riverton Memorial Hospital will be tobacco-free beginning Nov. 18. No tobacco use of any kind will be permitted inside or outside on hospital property.

While all of the buildings are currently smoke-free, the change will make the entire campus tobacco-free, both inside and out.

Tobacco receptacles and ashtrays will be removed from the premise before the policy takes effect.

Riverton Memorial Hospital is joining national and state efforts to reduce the negative health effects of tobacco use on the community. More than 1,400 Wyoming residents die in illnesses related to tobacco use each year. Tobacco use in and around hospitals poses health and safety risks for patients, employees and visitors.
